Launched in 2015, Independence 1 is a 48ft, twin engine purpose designed dive vessel, equipped with contemporary facilities and cutting-edge technology. There are toilets and changing facilities, its rear platform features two ladders for easy access to and from the ocean.

**11.30am:** Enjoy morning tea/coffee, fruit cake, and fruit platter while moving to the next reef location.
